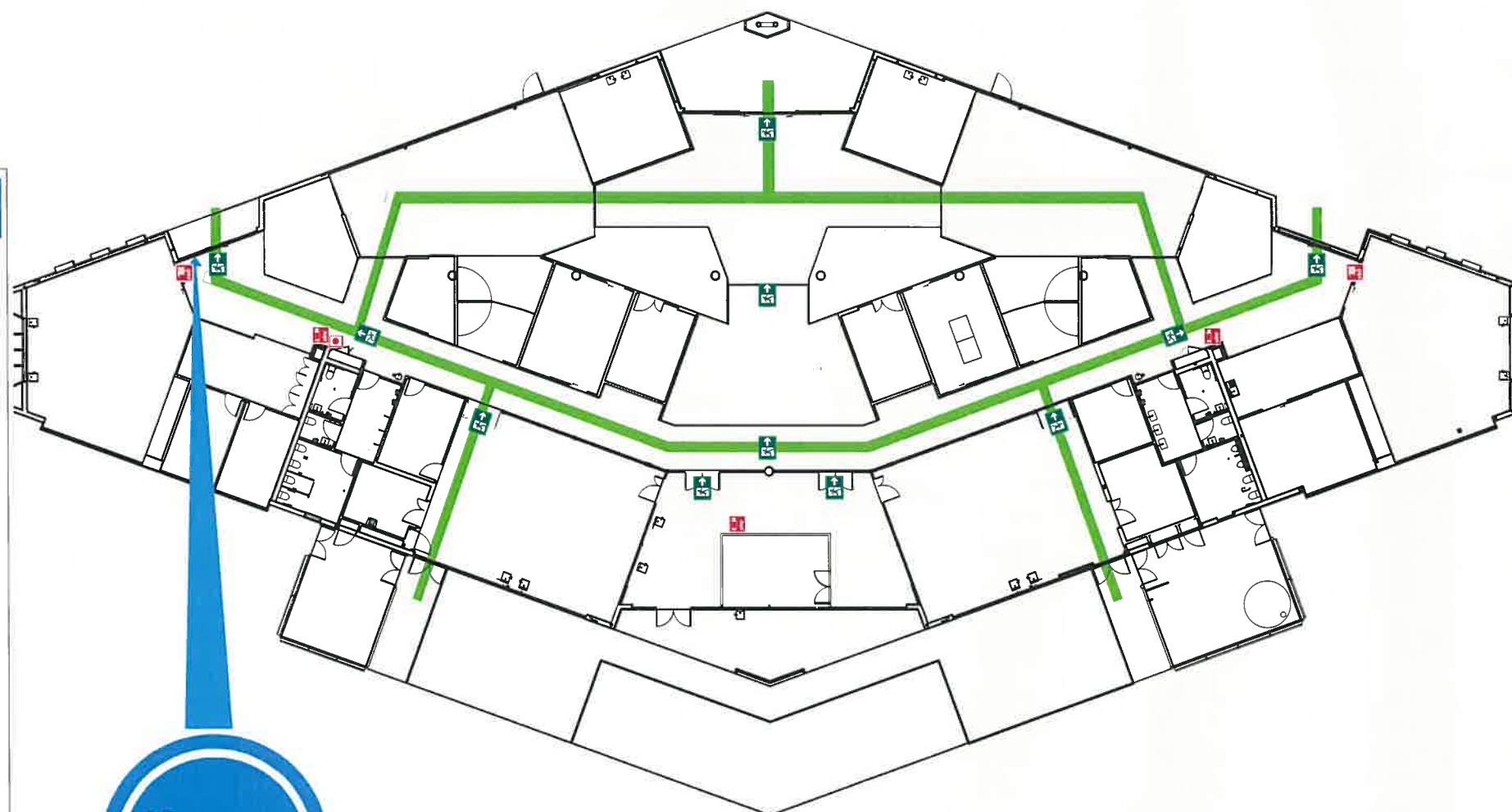
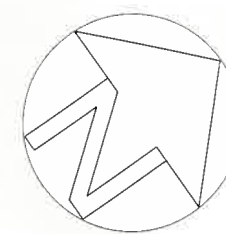










BUILDING EVACUATION DIAGRAM

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

WHEN THE ALERT TONE SOUNDS

BEEP... BEEP... BEEP...

When the ALERT tone sounds, stop what you are doing, Collect your personal belongings and wait for further instructions from Wardens /Security Personnel
DO NOT leave the building / area during the ALERT tone

WHEN THE EVACUATION TONE SOUNDS

WHOOOP... WHOOOP... WHOOOP

When the EVACUATION TONE sounds
Evacuate via the nearest "Exit" from your room/ area or as directed by Wardens / Security or PA announcements
NOTE: Do not use lifts - use stairwells only.
Once you have exited the building make your way to the nominated 'Assembly Area'.

ONCE YOU HAVE EVACUATED

Remain at the Assembly area until otherwise directed by Wardens/Security Personnel or Emergency Services.
DO NOT RE-ENTER a building until the 'All clear' is given.

SHELTER IN PLACE/LOCKDOWN (No Evacuation)

For some emergencies a SHELTER IN PLACE or LOCKDOWN will be required i.e. you will be required to **STAY IN THE BUILDING** rather than evacuating. Listen to any PA announcements and take directions from Wardens and or Security Personnel.

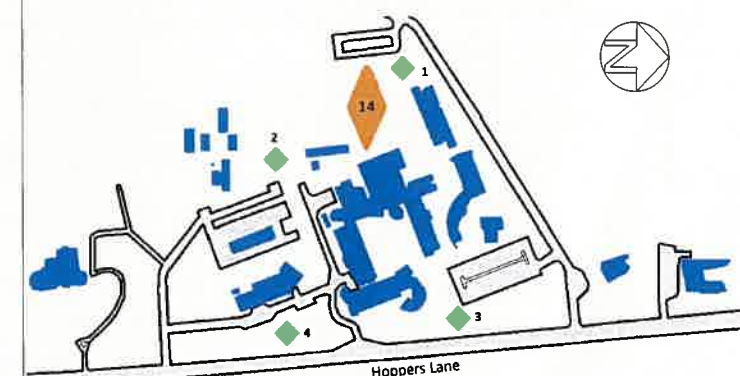
